FAQs

IS IT SAFE TO PLAY PAINTBALL?

Yes. Paintball is a very safe sport to play as long as players follow the rules. At the beginning of each session a safety briefing is held explaining the rules of the field and how to use a paintball marker. With safety equipment such as paintball approved masks, chest protectors, gloves and cricket boxes, together with fully trained referees at Castle Invasion we'll make sure you are not only safe, but have a great time. (Note: gloves and cricket boxes sold separately or as a special combo)

DOES PAINTBALL HURT?

Sometimes. Different people feel things differently. If you are wearing a chest protector, thick jumper or overalls then you might not even feel it. Generally the most you'd feel is a bit of an "ouch" with that going away in seconds. We enforce a 3 metre surrender rule so that you aren't shot at very close range and all our markers shoot below the legal 300 feet per second.

HOW OLD DO I HAVE TO BE?

To play paintball at Castle Invasion you must be at least 12 years old. Players between the ages of 12 – 16 yrs old must have a parent or guardian stay on site with them. Players 17 and over can play without parental supervision, however all players under 18 must have a signed membership form from their parent or guardian or they will not be allowed to play.

WHAT SUPERVISION IS THERE?

At Castle Invasion we make sure as a minimum there is at least 1 referee for every 10 players. Most of the time there will be 1 referee for 6 or 7 players, but we always have staff there to look after the players, help them stay safe and enjoy their day.

HOW MUCH PAINT WILL I USE?

From experience we have seen that the average player will go through anywhere from 400 to 600 Paintballs in a 3 hour session. Some players are very selective with their shooting, while other players shoot at anything that moves and even things that don't. In the end how much paint you use is completely up to you.

DO I NEED TO HAVE A GROUP TO COME AND PLAY?

No. If there is only yourself wanting to play paintball, then we can join you in with a group that is already booked. Saturdays are a great day for doing this as big groups generally come through. However, during the week we should be able to find some other players for you too. If you have a group of 6, then playing 3 against 3 can be as much fun as playing in a big group.

HOW DO I BOOK IN TO PLAY?

To book simply click on the bookings link on the web page and fill in your details. Your email will be answered within 48 hours maximum. You can call our booking line from 8am to 9pm on 0417 142 695 to book or enquire about your next game.

WHY DO I NEED TO PAY A DEPOSIT?

This is a very important issue for us. There is a lot of preparation that goes into setting up for each player. We also need to book our staff and calculate the amount of staff we have, dependant on the amount of players for one session. If you simply just don't turn up, or your number of players is not close to what you booked, it causes problems for us where we have equipment set up and referees booked that we may not need. Worse still, it could prevent a group from playing on their special day such as bucks or birthdays.

FAQs

CAN I BRING MY OWN EQUIPMENT?

Absolutely. We encourage any players to bring their own markers, masks, camo and field gear. Players bringing markers must have them currently licensed and bring their license with them. Masks must be approved for playing paintball. Paintballs are not to be brought with you but must be purchased on site. We have special deals for people bringing their own markers. It may also be of benefit to become a member of the Castle Invasion Knights club. We will also test marker for speed.

WHAT ABOUT ALCOHOL OR DRUGS?

We will only allow alcoholic drinks to be brought on site in an esky and is held onto by us until your gaming is completely finished. We will not allow anyone to enter our fields or handle our equipment if we suspect someone is under the influence of alcohol or drugs. This might mean that any heavy drinking, leading to hangovers from the night before, may have to be curtailed (so bucks please be aware).

WHAT SHOULD I WEAR?

Depending on the temperature of the day shorts/trackpants or jeans and a t-shirt are perfect. Once you get running around you will find you stay very warm. When you go out on the field you have full overalls to go over the top of your clothing. We also recommend bringing a scarf, gloves or a cricket box; however we do sell cricket boxes and gloves in our pro shop.

CAN I WEAR MY GLASSES AND STILL PLAY PAINTBALL?

Yes you can. Most glasses will fit comfortably underneath our masks. If you do wear glasses, let one of our staff know and we will apply some anti-fog solution to your glasses.

WHAT HAPPENS IN BAD WEATHER?

Paintball is played in all different weather conditions. It is played in many different countries in the world and suitable for all conditions. Like many outdoor sports, some people even find paintball more fun when it's raining.

WHAT HAPPENS IF WE DON'T SHOW UP OR CANCEL?

If you are unable to make your session for any reason, please notify us as soon as possible so we can book you in at another time. Bookings must be cancelled no later than 24 hours before, otherwise you will lose your deposit. A group not showing up for a session will also lose their deposit, as referees still have to be paid for the session they were supposed to work.
